1. Applied Technology Center (20-A MRSA 8301-A et seq)
 - a. Educational course or program designed to create or improve job-related skills that is part of the high school curriculum and is approved by the Commissioner of the DOE, may also include alternative educational programs and education/training in music, athletics, art or other activities approved by the Commissioner
 - b. Available to students residing in district and entitled to free public secondary education
 - c. Located in either center, satellite program or region within or outside geographical area of school district
 - d. The Applied Technology Center must have published admission standards
 - e. Priority to students who reside in the program's geographical region
 - f. If 20 or older, can attend Center so long as space available; adult can be charged a reasonable fee
